I would like to express our sincere appreciation for Adams Electric Company and the key role they played in the success of the Caesarstone Technologies USA Manufacturing Facility project. In Omega Construction's role as design-builder, one of our most critical duties was to assemble a team of design-build subcontractors that could meet the varied demands of this project, which included working with an international Owner having no US construction experience, adapting the Owner's design criteria to US standards, extensive coordination with foreign equipment suppliers, and an aggressive design and construction schedule. For the electrical scope, this was particularly challenging as the Owner's process and equipment design was being finalized well into the construction period for the project.

Omega Construction chose Adam Electric Company as our electrical design-build partner because we knew from our years of working with Adams that they had the technical skill, manpower, and wealth of industrial design-build experience necessary to successfully meet the demands of this project.
